

Kids Spring Showcase 2022 Information

Sleeping Beauty

Show Dates: May 20th, 21st and 22nd

Show Times: Friday, May 20th at 7pm, Saturday May 21st at 2pm, 4pm and 7pm,
*Sunday, May 22nd at 2pm and 4pm (*if needed)

Show Location: elite Dance Studios

Tickets:

- Ticket prices are \$15 per seat. Tickets are required for all human beings.
- There will be limited seating for shows. We will start with getting reservations from each family. Once we know that we have accommodated everyone, we will let you know so that you can purchase your tickets at the office (cash or check).

Rehearsal Schedule:

- Students will learn their dance pieces in their Ballet classes beginning March 7th, 2022. It is important that they attend their classes on a regular basis.
- JR CO will rehearse in their Ballet and JR CO Class.
- Actors will rehearse on Saturdays April 16th, 23rd, 30th, and May 7th 1:30-3:30pm.
- Dress Rehearsal for all Level 4, 5 and JR CO dancers ONLY on Saturday, May 14th from 1:30-3:30pm

Registration:

- Show performances are offered to students attending Kids A, Kids B, JR Inter & JR Advanced classes
- **Registration for Kids Ballet Students: \$35 per student (fee provides costumes and tights)**
- **Registration for JR Ballet and JR CO Students: \$45 (fee provides for JR Ballet dance piece, and JR CO costume basics)**
- Registration will begin **March 7th, 2022 ending on March 26th**, Office Managers will assist parents in registering their students during class hours.
- Late registration must be through the office. Costume and cast availability will determine acceptance of a late registration and will have a \$20 late fee.
- **HOW TO REGISTER: please make an appointment with your Office Manager to come into the studio to register your students.**

Costume Fittings:

- Office Managers will be fitting students for costumes in the month of March and as parents register them for the show.

Dress Rehearsals:

- Kids A & Kids B students have their dress rehearsal during their normal classes at the studio May 9th or 14th. Students come IN FULL COSTUME W HAIR IN A BUN.
- Dancers will be given their costumes BEFORE the week of their scheduled dress rehearsals at the studio and will be responsible for their costumes for the show.
- The elite Office must be made aware of any costume problems (defective or missing items) immediately. *Note: Alterations are the parent's responsibility.

JR Company:

- JR CO rehearsals will be during their Company classes on Saturdays.
- Company members that do not attend all rehearsals consistently will be used as understudies.
- IMPORTANT: Auditions for acting parts will be during JR CO rehearsals on March 5th.
- Actors will rehearse on Saturdays April 16th, 23rd, 30th, May 2nd 1:30-3:30pm.
- Dress Rehearsal for all Level 4, 5 and JR CO dancers ONLY from 1:30-3:30pm on Saturday May 14th.

Soloists:

- You will be contacted by your assigned coach to schedule times to learn and rehearse your choreography.

Show Day :

Dancer check-in times are as follows. Note: we will not check in dancers any earlier than the times listed below. Please do not be late!

- **JR CO, JR Inter, JR Adv:** Forty-five minutes prior to the show
- **Kids A & B:** Thirty-five minutes prior to the show

The house will open 30 minutes before the show for Guests to find seats. Parents with dancers that have a later check in time, please feel free to find your seats first, take your child to the restroom and then check them in. Seating will be General Admission.

We have staff/chaperones to take care of the children backstage at all times. Our chaperones will check in your children at the appointed time (see check-in times above).

Items to be checked in with your dancer: Please make sure all performance items, including shoes are labeled with dancer's name before check in. Parent's please keep all non-performance items in your car, as this will keep our dressing room and performance spaces clear of extra items.

Make Up/Hair:

- elite will provide make up for the dancers.
- Dancers need to wear their hair in a bun WITH a hair net over the bun (can be purchased at Walgreens). If a child's hair is too short to be put in a bun, hair needs to be back in clips (that match their hair) and must be off the face. Absolutely NO BANGS! Use a lot of hair spray.
- Boys, please have hair neat and tidy.
- **Please remove nail polish and jewelry (Including ear rings).**

Costumes:

- Costumes are included in the registration fee (including tights).
- Dancers will be given their costumes BEFORE their scheduled dress rehearsals at the studio and will be responsible for their costumes for the show.
- IMPORTANT: JR dancers will need to come to the dress rehearsals and shows in their first costume (including tights and hair done)

Additional Supplies Needed: Dancers will need to provide these dancewear basics and have them by dress rehearsals.

- All Classes: Ballet Slippers for all dancers
- BOYS: Short sleeved body armor shirt, black dress pants, black jazz or dress shoes.

Parents and Guests:

- Parents may photograph and videotape **during dress rehearsals** at the studio.
- There will be photo opportunities available with soloists and groups after each show. Photography/Videotaping will not be allowed during the shows. Note: If we have issues with parents or guests with this, we will stop the show and escort anyone out that refuses to cooperate.
- elite will be photographing and videotaping for promotional purposes, but will not be sharing those with the general public.
- No one is allowed backstage or in dressing rooms, unless they have volunteered and signed up for a job with the studio staff.
