Show Dates: May 3rd, 4th & 5th

Workshop Dates (Final Show Prep): April 27th-May 2nd

Show Times: Friday 7:00 pm, Saturday 12pm, 2pm, 4pm, 6pm Sunday 2:30pm

Note: Days/times will depend on the amount of registered participants and projected audience attendance. Once we have closed registration we will put students into casts (Cast A, B, C, etc) and then assign a day/time for their show.

Show Location: elite Black Box Theatre (701 Osuna Rd NE, Suite 1200)

Tickets:

- Ticket prices are \$20 per seat. Tickets are required for all human beings, including infants.
- There will be limited seating for shows. Be sure to purchase early. Tickets will be sold on the elite website Show Ticket page at <https://www.elitedancetheatre.com/tickets-page>

Rehearsal Schedule:

- Classes will begin to learn their show pieces in March. Attendance in March is very important.
- Show Workshop Week: April 27th-May 2nd. Attendance for the workshop is very important! *Note: We will NOT have a normal class schedule this month due to our professional shows and aerial intensive. Your class hours for April will all be during our Show Workshop week.*

Registration:

- Show performances are offered to students attending Preschool, Kids Ballet, Ballet Beginnings, JR Ballet, and JR Acting Classes.

- Registration for all Participants: \$65 per student (fee provides costumes, tights, accessories)
- Registration will begin January 15th and end February 15th. Office Managers will assist parents in registering their students during class hours (Mon/Thurs/Sat).
- Costume availability (order availability and delivery time) will determine acceptance of a late registration and will have a \$20 late fee.

Costume Fittings:

- Office Managers will be fitting students for costumes January 15th-February 15th as parents register them for the show.

Dress Rehearsals:

- Participants will have their dress rehearsals during the second day of their Workshop Week assigned rehearsals.
- We plan to hand out costumes the last week of March in classes. If costumes are not in by then, we will call and give times that costumes can be picked up at the studio.
- The elite Office must be made aware of any costume problems (defective or missing items) immediately. Email us so that we have a record of your communication. *Note: Alterations are the parent's responsibility.

Show Day :

Participant check-in times are as follows. Note: we will not check in dancers any earlier than the times listed below. Please do not be late!

- **JR Ballet and Actors:** Forty-five minutes prior to the show
- **Preschool, Kids Ballet and Ballet Beginnings:** Thirty minutes prior to the show

The house will open 30 minutes before the show for Guests.

We have staff/chaperones to take care of the children backstage at all times. Our chaperones will check in your children at the appointed time (see check-in times above).

Items to be checked in with your dancer: Please make sure all performance items, including shoes are labeled with dancer's name before check in. Parent's please keep all non-performance items in your car, as this will keep our dressing room and performance spaces clear of extra items.

Make Up/Hair:

- elite will apply light "theatre" make up using pencils, jewels, etc.
- Dancers need to wear their hair in a bun WITH a hair net over the bun (can be purchased at Walgreens). If a child's hair is too short to be put in a bun, hair

- needs to be back in clips (that match their hair) and must be off the face.
Absolutely NO BANGS! Use a lot of hair spray.
- Boys, please have hair neat and tidy.
 - Please remove nail polish and jewelry (Including ear rings).

Costumes:

- Costumes are included in the registration fee (including tights & accesories).
- Dancers will be given their costumes BEFORE their scheduled dress rehearsals at the studio and will be responsible for their costumes for the show.
- IMPORTANT: dancers with a costume change should come in their first costume.

Additional Supplies Needed: Dancers will need to provide these dancewear basics and have them by dress rehearsals.

- All Classes: Ballet Slippers for all dancers
- BOYS: Short sleeved body armor shirt, black dress pants, black jazz or dress shoes.

Parents and Guests:

- Parents may photograph and videotape **ONLY during dress rehearsals** at the studio. NOTE: You may only photograph/videotape your own child.
- There will be photo opportunities available with soloists and groups after each show. Photography/Videotaping will not be allowed during the shows. Note: If we have issues with parents or guests with this, we will stop the show and escort anyone out that refuses to cooperate.
- elite will be photographing and videotaping for promotional purposes, but will not be sharing those with the general public.
- No one is allowed backstage or in dressing rooms unless they have volunteered and signed up for a job with the studio staff.
