Who Can Register:

Kids 8-14 years of age. No experience needed! Space is limited. KTP participants will be cast in lead and supporting roles for the show.

Workshop Schedule:

May 24th, 2022: Kick off Rehearsal (Informal Auditions) Tuesday 6:30-7:30pm

June 13th-17th, 2022: Monday through Thursday from **12:30-3:30pm** at the studio for scene work, backstage work, costume and prop construction. Friday 4:00pm-9pm for shows.

Shows:

We will be presenting our completed shows on **Friday, June 17th at 6:00pm, 7:00pm and 8:00pm** at elite for live performances. Tickets will be \$15 and can be purchased on the elite website's SHOWS page beginning June 13th, 2022.

Registration:

- Registration fees for KTP Workshop (ages 8-14yrs): **\$95**
- Registration will begin **April 25th-May 23rd**. Late registration must be through the office. Cast availability will determine acceptance of a late registration and will have a \$25 late fee.

Kick Off Rehearsal and Part Assignments:

We will be holding a Kick Off Rehearsal on May 24th from 6:30-7:30pm (Tuesday) for an informal Audition. Participants that cannot attend this rehearsal will still be assigned a part! Casting and Script will be sent out on May 30th, 2022 by email. Participants will memorize their lines before the workshop begins on June 13th. What to wear for the Workshop: Comfortable clothes that kids can move in and CLOSED toe shoes. No sandals or flip flops.

Costumes:

- The Kids Theatre Project focuses on all aspects of “creating” an entire show, which will include costumes. We will send out a list of “basics” on the first day of our workshop that each participant will need to provide for themselves which are normally things you can find in your closet or at Goodwill. Additional pieces and accessories will be made during our workshops.
