#### **Tickets:**

- Ticket prices are \$25 per seat. Tickets are required for all human beings, including infants. Reserved Seating.

#### **Registration for Kids Theatre Project:**

- **Show Registration** for KTP Participants: \$25 per theater student (fee provides supplies for costumes, props, and professional photo downloads)
- NOTE: After we cast roles, we will send an email with basic costume items needed for students. These items can be found in your closet or at a local thrift store.
- Registration is from May 19th-June 2nd, 2025.

#### **Registration for Aerial Cirque Performance:**

- For all Aerial students participating in classes in June and July, 2025
- Registration Fee: \$30 for Aerial students (fee provides costume performance leotard and professional photo downloads)
- Participants will provide their own black yoga type pants for their costume.
- Registration is from May 19th-June 2nd, 2025.
- Office Managers are available to help parents register their students during class hours (Mondays and Saturdays).
- Costume availability (order availability and delivery time) will determine approval for a late registration and will have a \$20 late fee.

#### **Rehearsal Schedule:**

- Classes will begin to learn their show pieces in **June**. Attendance in **June and July** is very important.

### **Dress Rehearsals:**

- Participants will have their dress rehearsals during the last week of July 26th-August 1st.
- Aerial leotards will be handed out the week of July 14th in classes
- One parent per family may attend dress rehearsal to take photos and videos of their own children. **We will not allow extra observers during dress rehearsals.** Cameras/Phones will not be allowed during the performance at the theatre. elite has professional photographers that will be taking photos of all performances and will provide unlimited downloads as part of your registration fee.

### **Show Day:**

- Kids Theatre Project: Come in your costume basics.
- Aerial Cirque Performers: Come in your costume.
- If students are in both KTP and Aerial, please come in your KTP basics costume and bring your Aerial costume with you.
- Performers will arrive in their first costume, with hair done. Parents, please take your children to the restroom (in the lobby) before checking in.
- Please bring snacks (that won't make a mess!) and water bottles.

Student check-in times are as follows. Note: we will not check in students any earlier than the times listed below. Please do not be late!

• Kids Theatre Project	11:30pm
• Aerial Cirque Performers Arrive	12:45pm
• Lobby Opens for seating	1:30pm
• Show	2:00pm

The house will open 30 minutes before the show for Guests to find their seats. Please be aware that the NM Fairgrounds charges a parking fee.

We have staff/instructors/chaperones to take care of the children backstage at all times. Our staff will check in your children at the appointed time (see check-in times above).

Items to be checked in with your dancer: Please make sure all performance items, including shoes are labeled with dancer's name before check in. Parents will keep extra items (coats, street shoes, etc. with them).

#### **Make Up/Hair:**

- elite will apply light “theatre” make up using pencils, jewels, etc.
- Dancers need to wear their hair in a bun WITH a hair net over the bun (can be purchased at Walgreens/Walmart). If a child’s hair is too short to be put in a bun, hair needs to be back in clips (that match their hair) and must be off the face. Absolutely NO BANGS! Use a lot of hair spray.
- Boys, please have hair neat and tidy.
- Please remove nail polish and jewelry (Including earrings).

#### **Costumes:**

- Kids Theatre Project: Come in your costume basics.
- Aerial Cirque Performers: Come in your costume.
- If students are in both KTP and Aerial, please come in your Aerial costume and bring your KTP costume with you.
- Performers will arrive in their first costume, with hair done. Parents, please take your children to the restroom (in the lobby) before checking in.

#### **Parents and Guests:**

- One parent per family may attend dress rehearsal to photograph and videotape. You may only photograph/videotape your own children. You may only post photos on-line of your own children. This is a safety and privacy issue for all of our elite children. No extra observers will be allowed.
- There will be no photography or videotaping during the performance. If we have issues with parents or guests with this, our security will stop the show and escort anyone out that refuses to cooperate. elite will have our own professional photographers at the show, and will make those photos available on-line to our customers. Unlimited downloads are part of your registration fee!
- We take the safety and security of our little ones seriously. No one is allowed backstage or in dressing rooms unless they have volunteered and signed up for a job with the studio staff.
- At check in, we will allow one parent to bring their child into the dressing room if needed to ensure that they are comfortable and ready to perform. **The parent that checks in the child must be the parent that checks out their child.**
- Children should not be left unattended at any time inside or outside the theatre.
